

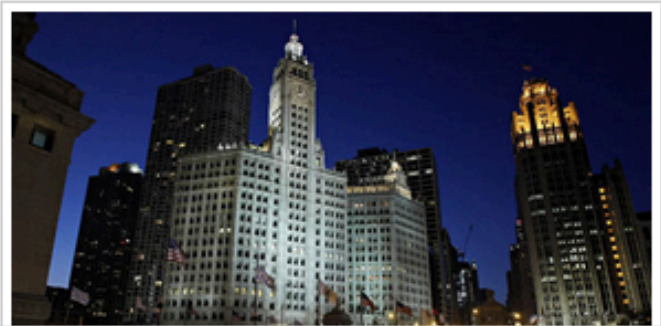
14 commercial buildings join municipal energy-efficiency effort

Owners of 14 downtown commercial buildings will invest in making their structures more energy-efficient as part of the city's "Retrofit Chicago" program, Mayor Rahm Emanuel announced Tuesday afternoon.

The private effort, with technical and financial support from associations, foundations and energy companies, is projected to cut energy costs by \$5 million a year. No public funds will be used, the mayor said.
